Calculations of points on admission to the doctoral school:

Grade points (The grade point averages are scaled to the maximum of 5.00):

- If the graduation was within 3 years (max. 25 points) (grade point average for all subjects in the transcript of the BSc certificate -3.5) $\times 20/3$ (grade point average for all subjects in the transcript of the MSc certificate -3.5) $\times 10$

- If the graduation was more than 3 years (max. 20 points) (grade point average for all subjects in the transcript of the BSc certificate -3.5) \times 16/3 (grade point average for all subjects in the transcript of the MSc certificate -3.5) \times 8

The results are rounded to integers.

<u>Scientific achievements:</u>

If the graduation was within 3 years (max. 25 points)
If the graduation was more than 3 years (max. 30 points)

Scientific achievements in details:

- 12 points, who won I-III prizes or a special prize at National Scientific Research Conference (or its equivalent)
- 5 points to present scientific research results at University Scientific Research Conferences (or their equivalents) (max. 10 points)
- 5 points for every lecture or poster presentation co-authored at international scientific
- conferences (overall max. 15 points)
- 10 points for every scientific publication co-authored in scientific journals with impact factor or book published in English (overall max. 20 points)
- 5 points for every scientific publication co-authored in scientific journals in any languages (overall max. 10 points)
- 5 points for every scientific publication co-authored in any scientific journals with no impact factor (overall max. 10 points)

Oral interview:

Oral interview in front of the Entrance Examination Committee on topics related to previous research experience (max. 30 points).

Extra scores for language examination certificate (max. 5 points):

C1 (Advanced) English language examination certificate (5 points) B2 language examination certificate (3 points)

Condition for admission is to reach at least half of the maximum points of 85, that is at least 42.5 points. In the case of the TEMPUS Public Foundation programs (Stipendium Hungaricum, Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship, etc) the minimum is 56% (48 points).
